



First take the four screws off.






Then detatch the plastic clip from the bottom of the control unit. Then pull the control unit out of its place.





Then take off the connector from the white base by using a flat head and pushing the middle away from the blower motor.





To reinstall the new blower motor, slide the connector back into the white plastic base.





Slide the control unit bracket into the rectangle hole of the metal housing.



Put the metal housing and the blower motor on top of each other. Align the four screw holes. Slowly screw the housing into the blower motor.







Lastly, slide the plastic clip for the control unit.
